DESCRIPTION OF ITEM

ITEM 1 - BROOCH

A lady's platinum antique rectangular brooch from the Art Deco period (Circa 1910's-1930's), featuring bezel set shield and bullet shaped diamonds alternating with bead set old Euro and single cut round diamonds. The brooch has a high polished finish, and an early screw style locking pin catch. The pin itself is 18k white gold. Details include:
