**Description:**

One pair of tested 14KT yellow gold lady's combination cast & assembled antique Art Nouveau earrings with lever backs and a bright polish finish. These earrings feature pearls and diamonds. They measure 52 mm in length and 18 mm in width. They weigh 12.1 grams. Condition is fair. A few stones are missing and one earring needs a soldering repair.





**Containing:**

Fifty-Four bead set rose cut diamonds, measuring 2.20 - 1.00 x 0.99mm (depth est.) approximate total weight of 54 Stones = 0.59ct.

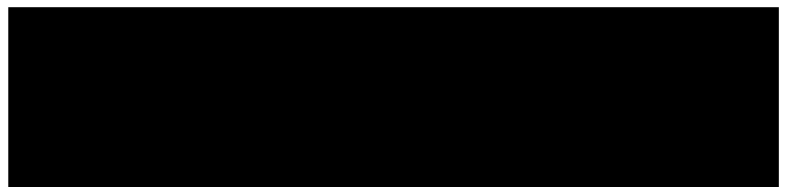
