JEWELRY APPRAISAL

THE FOREGOING APPRAISAL WAS MADE WITH THE UNDERSTANDING THAT THE APPRAISER ASSUMES NO LIABILITY WITH RESPECT TO ANY ACTION THAT MAY BE TAKEN ON THE BASIS OF THIS APPRAISAL. DIAMOND GRADES REFERRED TO IN THIS APPRAISAL ARE THOSE DEFINED BY THE GEMOLOGICAL INSTITUTE OF AMERICA (GIA) UNLESS ANOTHER RECOGNIZED LABORATORY GRADING REPORT IS CITED. APPROXIMATE WEIGHTS ARE FORMULATED BY MEASUREMENTS AND ARE ESTIMATES ONLY. UNLESS OTHERWISE NOTED ALL STONES WERE GRADED WHILE MOUNTED. WHILE EVERY EFFORT HAS BEEN MADE TO GRADE THE GEMSTONES DESCRIBED AS ACCURATELY AS POSSIBLE, DIAMONDS IN THEIR SETTINGS CAN BE GRADED FOR COLOR AND QUALITY ONLY TO THE EXTENT PERMITTED BY THE SETTING. 1. 14 KARAT (STAMPED 14K) WHITE GOLD ENGAGEMENT RING THAT WAS CONSTRUCTED BY SOLDERING TOGETHER 2 WEDDING RINGS AND REMOVING THE 2 CENTER FULL CUT DIAMONDS FROM BOTH BANDS. THE CENTER OF THE RING HAS BEEN FITTED WITH A SQUARE 4 PRONG HEAD THAT IS SET WITH A PRINCESS CUT DIAMOND. THE PRINCESS CUT DIAMOND ("I" COLOR, "I2" CLARITY) MEASURING 7.25MM X 6.92MM X 4.23MM WEIGHING APPROXIMATELY 1.79 CARAT (BY CALCULATION). THE SIDES OF THE RING ARE SET WITH 16 FULL CUT DIAMONDS ("H" COLOR, "I1" CLARITY) WEIGHING A TOTAL OF APPROXIMATELY 2.40 CARATS. TOTAL RING WEIGHT IS 12.59 GRAMS.
