Key build points:

- Full “frame off” restoration including sandblasting and painting of the frame and body
- Many body panels replaced with new or reconditioned by Fanshawe Autobody program staff and students
- New Glass, tint and rubber seals all around
- Carbon fiber graphics custom designed and installed by Fanshawe college Autobody staff and students
- Many Chassis upgrades such as: power brakes, 4-wheel disc brake upgrade, Updated suspension to “Mustang II”, sway bar upgrades, 4 link rear suspension upgrade
- Upgraded Coil-over suspension
- Rebuilt and upgraded Ford 9” differential
- Rebuilt and upgraded Ford 4R70W transmission, rebuilt at Fanshawe college by staff and students
- New 18” BOSS tires and rims
- Reupholstered and upgraded interior, new carpets
- Custom embroidered Fanshawe logos, custom Fanshawe decals, custom machined air cleaner with Fanshawe branding logos
- Custom dash, shifter, headliner, radio, speakers
- Upgraded / Modernized Ford 302 (345hp) crate engine with custom accessories
- Upgraded exhaust system and headers
- Modernized with electronic fuel injection and computer-controlled ignition system
- Upgraded cooling system including aluminum radiator and electric fans for better drivability.
- Added air conditioning for upgraded drivability
