1. Diamond, 10% iridium platinum ring. The diamond measures approximately 8.38 x 8.36 x 5.30 mm, and weighs approximateky 2.25 cts. Clarity grade:VS1 Color grade: I – J Table: 5.10 mm, 60.9 % Girdle: very thin, frosted

There are 2 baguette-cut diamonds weighing a total of approximately 0.15 ct., with SI clarity grades and G – H color grades. The ring weighs approximately 4.00 grams

Retro ruby, diamond, 14k yellow gold buckle motif strap bracelet. 23 full-cut and four single-cut diamonds weigh a total of approximately 1.85 cts., with VS2 to SI1 clarity grades and G – H color grades. 20 calibre-cut pinkish red rubies weigh a total of approximately 1.90 cts. The bracelet measures 8 ¹/₄ inches long by 1 1/8" wide and weighs approximately 91.20 grams
